Paper Zoo Theatre Company presents *An Evening with Joe Orton: Funeral Games and The Ruffian on the Stair* at the Yorkshire Craft Centre for two nights only on 7th & 8th September, before moving onto the Square Chapel Centre For The Arts, Halifax for one night on the 9th. The evening will comprise of two of Orton's best loved plays – *Ruffian On The Stair* and his final play *Funeral Games*.

Laura Milnes directs the adaptations of Joe Orton's *Ruffian on the Stair* and *Funeral Games* in a production devised by former Bradford College Students. Paper Zoo Theatre Company comprises of eight members; three tutors from the college, four graduates and a company manager. Having performed a showcase, *Road* by Jim Cartwright and the self-named devised piece – *Paper Zoo* as part of the course, the students chose to continue the enthusiasm for acting and form the company. The company includes Stuart Davies, Ben Eagle, Martin Knowles, Laura Milnes, Jonathan O'Connor, Damien O'Keeffe, Julia O'Keeffe, and David Peel. Thus far they have performed *A Christmas Carol* at The Priestley (Dec 2005), *Waiting For Godot* at the Yorkshire Craft Centre (Sept 2006), *Twelfth Night* at The Priestley (Dec 2006), *Funeral Games* at Bradford College (May 2007) and *Much Ado About Nothing* at the Bradford Cathedral (July 2007).

Two dark and twisted comic plays from British Theatre's most notorious witty prankster.

In "Ruffian..." a nervous woman, neglected by her questionable lover is tormented by a ruffian with a score to settle. "Funeral Games" meanwhile, is a macabre romp through religion, adultery and murder, loaded with farcical sin.

This celebration of sinners and their secrets is being staged to commemorate the 40th anniversary of writer Joe Orton's tragic death. Orton's combination of claustrophobia, immorality and mischief is temptingly, deliciously wicked, like the writer himself.
