Having performed a showcase, Road by Jim Cartwright and the self-named devised piece – Paper Zoo as part of the course, the students chose to continue their enthusiasm for acting and form the company. Thus far they have performed A Christmas Carol at The Priestley (Dec 2005), Waiting For Godot at the Yorkshire Craft Centre (Sept 2006), Twelfth Night at The Priestley (Dec 2006), Funeral Games at Bradford College (May 2007), Much Ado About Nothing at the Bradford Cathedral (July 2007), An Evening of Joe Orton at the Yorkshire Craft Centre and Square Chapel Centre for the Arts, Halifax (Sep 2007) and the recently completed tour of A Christmas Carol (Nov 2007 – Jan 2008).

This exciting and ultimately romantic evening will comprise of selected poems, songs and readings combined to form a heady concoction of love. The cast of seven will perform as a group and will also perform solo and in pairs. Selected readings will include poems by Thomas Hardy, Y.B. Yeats and W.H. Auden amongst others. Songs will include Hallelujah by Leonard Cohen, The Rose and Miss You Nights. The Company also bring their own twist to several well-known songs including the Madness hit It Must Be Love.

The ticket price will also include a tapas buffet, a half bottle of wine and mineral water.
